

## Welcome to *Good Strong Powerful* - Exhibition Review

**Imagine you are a news reporter.**

**Look around the exhibition, spend time reading, looking and making notes.**

**Describe the works to your reader as if they have never seen them. Tell the reader exactly what you can see.**

**Why do you think the exhibition is important?**

**How could it be better?**

First have a good look around the exhibition.

- Look closely at the artworks. Read the information.
- Talk to your friends about the exhibition.

You have been asked to write a review about the exhibition for your local newspaper.

Use the following as a guide.

- What is the title of the exhibition?
- What does the title mean?
- What is the exhibition about?
- Who are the artists and where do they come from?
- Who put the exhibition together and why?

Pick two artworks you like best:

- Describe them in detail.
- What special skills, knowledge and ability does the artist have?

Make a drawing of one of the artworks to illustrate your report.

Interview the gallery curator or ask them to tell your group about the exhibition.

Back in the classroom:

- Write about the things you liked most about the exhibition.
- Conduct a Google search on your favourite artist in the exhibition. Find out about who they are and where they live. Add this information to your notes.

Finally:

- Write your report.
- Create a title or headline for your article.
