

You be the Curator

You are to curate an exhibition of works from the Dubbo Regional Gallery and Dubbo Regional Museum Collections for display in the main gallery space of WPCG.

Step 1:

In pairs using a Mac computer go to the WPCG website and review previous exhibitions from the collection curated by WPCG Curator Kent Buchanan, including **Brood** and **Flight**. Examine the works included and read the floor sheets associated with each exhibition.

Step 2:

Review the works held in the collection via the online catalogue of the Dubbo Regional Gallery.

Step 3:

Work with your partner to complete the following:

1. Develop a theme around which you would like to centre your exhibition and establish a title for the show.
2. Select the works you would like to display in this exhibition in connection to this theme (Remember you are limited to the space of the main gallery as depicted in your floor plan).
3. Create a brief 250 word blurb which captures the essence of your exhibition. This would be used at the entrance to the exhibition, in promotional material and on an exhibition invitation.
4. Develop a plan for the exhibition layout in the space provided on the floor sheet using images of the works to determine the most effective layout.
5. Design an invitation for your show. Create a stylised version of the exhibition title that can be used at the exhibition entrance and on the floorsheet, as well as for this invitation. Select a key image (likely the work used as the focal point in your layout) that will be representative of your exhibition from the works included and add your blurb.
6. Create a floor sheet for your exhibition which should include:
 - Your exhibition title.
 - Your key image.
 - a 500 word blurb which conveys the meaning of the exhibition to the audience (expanding upon your 250 word overview). This should enlighten the viewer to the significance of the title of your exhibition and highlight the connections that can be made between the works based on your chosen theme.
7. Present your exhibition proposal to rest of the class.
